Skate Park Admission/Usage Changed

The Shakopee Skate Park, located on the northeast side of the Community Center, has changed its usage to include both skateboards and bikes. Additionally, admission is now FREE. However, park users must obtain a wristband at the Community Center Service Desk to enter the facility.



The Shakopee Skate Park is a Tier 1 facility that includes True Ride Inc. equipment like half-pyramid, grind box and rail, mini ramp with a spine, hip with

landing, wedges, stair box, street spine, and much more. The park opens at 9 a.m., Monday through Saturday and 10 a.m., Sunday and closes at dusk during the spring.

Buy a New Tree at the Arbor Day Tree Sale

If you're looking for a new tree, come to the Arbor Day Tree Sale on Saturday, April 30 from 1 to 3 p.m. at the Shakopee Public Works Building (400 Gorman Street). Shakopee residents (I.D. required) can buy one containerized tree per household at less than wholesale prices.



A limited number of the following tree species will be available on the day of the sale: Northern Pin Oak (\$100), Princeton Elm (\$100), White Pine (\$60), Black Hills Spruce (\$80), and Spring Snow Crabapple (\$100). Trees will be sold on a first-come-first-served basis on the day of the sale.

Buyers will be responsible for transporting the tree at the time of sale and planting it. Buyers are advised that many of the trees are 10 to 12 feet tall and can weigh up to 120 pounds.

The City has discounted the wholesale price to encourage tree planting throughout the city.
