



2011 Bituminous Overlay Project

CONTRACT

The Shakopee City Council awarded the contract for the 2011 Bituminous Overlay to Minnesota Roadways Co., of Shakopee, at the May 3, 2011 City Council Meeting.

What is the purpose of this project?

This project is to provide an improved smoother driving surface. An overlay is a structural improvement that renews the street surface and extends the life cycle of the original pavement. No major excavation will be performed.

CONSTRUCTION SCOPE

- The bituminous (blacktop) roadway surface will be milled near the curb. This construction will use a large machine to grind up the material.
- Poor street areas will be removed and patched with new bituminous.
- A new bituminous surface will be placed directly on to the existing surface.
- Interim and new permanent pavement striping will be installed on Vierling drive.

TRAFFIC

Traffic will be affected slightly, with a few road closings for short durations while paving. Driving lanes will be altered during construction activities. Please do not drive on the fresh blacktop until the rolling process is complete.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much will this cost me?: There will be no assessments for these improvements.

Access to driveways: Occasionally, the contractor may be working directly in front of your driveway and access may be limited for a short period of time (30-40 minutes).

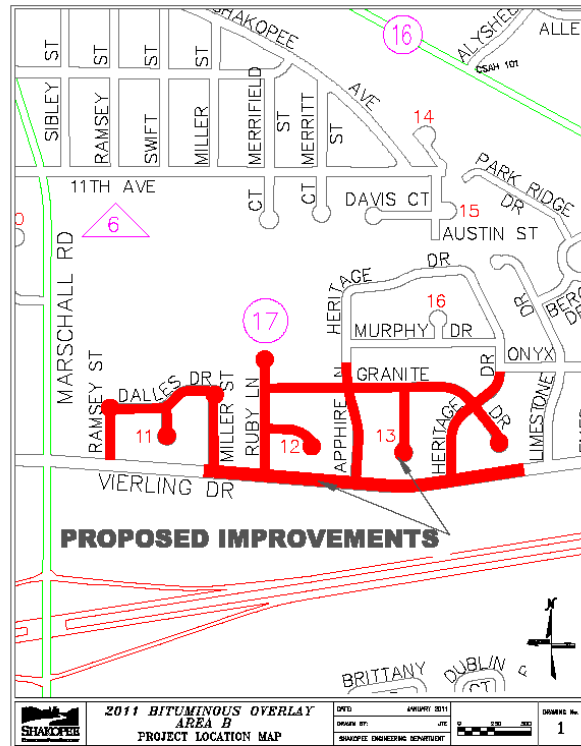
Garbage/Mail: We do not anticipate any disruptions with your garbage or mail service.

Will my driveway be worked on?: No. This is a pavement preservation project. Only the street will be effected.

SCHEDULE

The construction is scheduled to begin mid June with milling of the roadway and street patching followed by the paving. When a more detailed estimated construction schedule is available it will be posted at www.ci.shakopee.mn.us/street_closings.cfm.
