The "Index Factor" would then be applied to the "gross" building permit to derive the "net" building permit fee which should be no less than the minimum, and no more than the maximum Building Permit Fee.

REFUNDS: Upon request and review, up to 80% of the fee(s) paid may be reimbursed for permits that are abandoned or unused.

When permit application has been reviewed and processed there will be a minimum plan review fee assessed if applicant chooses to significantly change, alter, or abandon application/plans.

State Surcharge: Building Permits

The Minnesota Statutes § 326B.148 "SURCHARGE" has been changed for one year effective July 1, 2010, until June 30, 2011.

The change only applies to the "Permits based on Fixed Fees, Part 1" and "Permits based on Fixed Fees, Part 2" portions of the **Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry's (DLI) surcharge reporting form.**

The minimum surcharge for a "fixed fee" permit is \$5, beginning July 1, 2010.

Building Permit - Related Escrows-

The City may accept one payment for all named escrows of its discretion, and no portion of these escrows shall be released unless final compliance with City requirements is verified.

1) Certificate of Occupancy Escrow (Authorized by Res. No. 2604)

- a) Commercial/Industrial .005 x value, or \$500.00, whichever is greater
- b) Residential .005 x value, with a \$750.00 maximum

100% of the fee shall be refunded when a final certificate of occupancy is issued.

2) Landscaping Escrow: A \$1500.00 escrow will be required, for landscaping and will be refunded in whole to the Applicant when landscaping requirements have been completed.

3) Erosion Control Escrow: A \$1000.00 escrow will be required in order to guarantee the installation and removal of all required erosion and sediment control measures. The City is authorized to draw against this escrow in the event the building permit applicant fails to comply. The Escrow is required under City Code Chapter 16.

Notes for the Fee Schedule

Administrative Costs - Actions requiring payment for administrative costs may be billed to the applicant. Administrative costs may include but are not limited to the following: staff time, (including regular City employees and contracted employees), publishing costs, copying, printing and mailing. The actual hourly rates of the employees will be used plus a multiplier of 2.0 times for benefits. A deposit of \$100.00 will be required to begin the work, any unused portion would be returned and invoices provided for work in excess of \$100.00 before work proceeds.

Administrative costs will accrue after the first meeting with the applicant.

Any escrows received by the City shall be monitored to ensure sufficient escrow funds are held by the City. Whena an escrow account reaches a balance of 10% of the original escrow amount, the City shall invoice the applicant for the submittal of additional escrow funds in an amount consistent with the original escrow submittal. This process shall continue until the City has completed all necessary reviews.

Engineering

A. Private Developments

The development fees for private developments apply in situations where private developers choose to construct the public improvements, rather than having them constructed by the City. The fees that the City charges in those situations are intended to reimburse the City for all of the direct and indirect costs incurred by the Public Works Departments to process the development application, to process and administer the project, to review and approve the plans for the project, and to inspect the construction of the project. The percentage used for various items are based on the historical costs incurred by the City.

The Developer shall reimburse the City for costs associated with the first bituminous seal coat performed on the bituminous paved streets within the plat. The costs shall be based on the latest contract unit prices the City has received plus 3% for next year's increases and administration costs. The estimated City fee shall be deposited with the City at the time the Developer's Agreement is signed.

Streets and Utilities

The Development Fees for private developments include a lump sum of 7.5% of the estimated construction costs for the following: public sanitary sewer, public storm sewer, public street construction, sidewalks, boulevard trees and other appurtenances. Storm water management reviews will be charged on an hourly basis. The developer shall deposit 2% (minimum of \$5,000) to pay for storm water management reviews.

Watermain

The Development Fees shall also include a lump sum of 4.0% of the estimated construction costs for public water, based on the following breakdown:

Administrative Fee	1.50%

Note: Watermain inspection fees are charged separately from the Shakopee Public Utility Commission

Grading Fee - Costs up to \$200,000

For grading projects up to \$200,000, the Development Fees shall also include a lump sum of 5.5% of the estimated construction costs for site grading and erosion control, with a minimum fee of \$50.00.

NPDES compliance inspections will be charged on an hourly basis. If outside consultants are used the costs will be charged to the developer. If City employees are used the developer will be charged actual hourly rates plus a multiplier of 2.0.

Unauthorized work permit Fee is up to double the permit fee

Grading Fee - Costs Greater than \$200,000

For grading projects greater than \$200,000, the Development Fees shall include a lump sum fee of \$11,000, plus a 3.0% inspection fee for the site grading and erosion control costs over \$200,000.

NPDES compliance inspections will be charged on an hourly basis. If outside consultants are used the costs will be charged to the developer. If City employees are used the developer will be charged actual hourly rates plus a multiplier of 2.0.

Unauthorized work permit Fee is up to double the permit fee

B. Trunk Storm Water Charges

Unauthorized Work Permit Fee is up to double the permit fee

A fee of \$.118 per developable square foot will be charged to all new developments, per the City's Trunk Storm Water Charge Policy. The term "net developable foot" means the total square footage of a development within the city limits minus the portion of the development used for public right-of-way, lakes, wetland areas, stormwater ponding easements, and parks.

C. Trunk Storm Water Storage and Treatment Charges

A fee will be charged to all new developments that utilize regional ponding systems, per the City's Trunk Storm Water Charge Policy. This fee shall be as follows:
